

Letter C Activities

1. Using the large C letter template

(<http://www.carlscorner.us.com/ABC/CCPC.pdf>), have your child glue on any of the following items:

Cotton Balls

Corn seed or candy corn

Cat stickers

2. Read the book Caps for Sale. Gather up all of the caps in your house. Sort them by like characteristics and count the hats in each category and then the total hats.

3. You and your child act out the story, Caps for Sale. You be the peddler and stack your collection of hats on your head. Have your child be the monkey. They will have no problem acting out the story as you narrate and play the main part.

4. Using the cat outline from the following website, have your child make a calico cat by laying different colored squares of tissue paper over the outline and then spray lightly with water. Remove the tissue and let dry.
