

# Sally Square

## What You Need:

- Paper
- Paste
- Paint

## What You Do:

- Have your children cut out two- 1" white square (eyes), One- 1" brown square (nose), a 2" red square (mouth), and Two - 2" blue squares (feet). Also provide them with four long yellow strips for arms and legs (have children fold back and forth to make legs zigzag). Finally, give them a 9" square body and have them put it together. They can use paint or markers to personalize their Sally Square. For added effect you can add goggly eyes. Feel free to let your child name their square any word that begins with the letter S.
