

Oval Shape

Study the oval shape by doing the following egg activities. Discuss things that have the oval shape.

Math

Write the numbers 1-12 in the bottom of each cup in a clean egg carton. Provide the children with cheerios or other small items. Have them place the correct number of cereal in each cup.

Use the same egg carton for another center. Write the numbers 1-12 on 12 plastic easter eggs. Have the children match the correct egg to the matching cup.

Music

Make musical shakers by placing rice in plastic easter eggs. Use E-6000 or hot glue to securely seal up the eggs. Make enough for each child to have two. Give two to each child at music time and let them shake them to the beat of the music.

To store the egg shakers, color the each egg carton compartment to match the egg that will go into it. This requires the children to match the colors each time they put their instruments away.
